- 1. How to recognize the signs of choking

- 3. How to properly execute the Heimlich Maneuver® to save someone from a choking emergency

Through a rich, interactive virtual learning lesson and – if your school provided it – hands-on practice with specially designed training dolls, your teen gained the knowledge and skills needed to provide help in this situation, and the confidence to step forward and become a Heimlich Hero.
